In December 2022, trend resident employment in the Territory increased by 0.3% to 141,287 persons. Full-time employment increased by 0.3% and part-time employment increased by 0.2%. Nationally, employment increased by 0.2%, with full-time employment increasing by 0.3% and part-time employment being flat.

Annually, trend resident employment increased by 5.7% in the Territory. Nationally, employment increased by 3.5% over the same period (Chart 1). In 2022, Territory employment increased by 4.0%, reflecting an increase in full-time employment of 5.8%, partly offset by a decrease in part-time employment of 1.7%. Nationally, year-on-year employment increased by 4.1%.



The Territory's trend unemployment rate was flat at 3.9% in the month of December 2022 (Chart 2). Nationally, the monthly unemployment rate was flat at 3.5%.



The trend participation rate in the Territory was flat at 74.0% in December 2022. The Territory's participation rate is the highest of the jurisdictions, and well above the national rate of 66.7% (Chart 3).




