Fuel prices

December 2024 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for December 2024 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 05 January 2025 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in the Territory was 191.9 cpl, 5.0 cpl higher than the previous month, however 8.9 cpl lower over the year (Chart 1). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 186.1 cpl, 9.4 cpl higher than the previous month, however 1.5 cpl lower over the year.


In Darwin, the average ULP price was 175.9 cpl, 6.9 cpl higher than the previous month, however 10.3 cpl lower over the year. This was the second lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 174.8 cpl in Perth to 197.2 cpl in Brisbane (Chart 2).


The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 170.0 cpl, 3.1 cpl higher than the previous month, however 0.4 cpl lower over the year. The average TGP nationally was 165.7 cpl, 3.2 cpl higher than the previous month, however 0.5 cpl lower over the year.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin increased by 3.7 cpl to 5.8 cpl (Chart 3). This was the lowest GIRD of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 9.7 cpl in Perth to 31.9 cpl in Brisbane. The national average GIRD for ULP increased by 6.3 cpl to 20.4 cpl in the month.

ACCC fuel price monitoring

The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the September quarter 2024 on 27 November 2024. The Report can be accessed <u>here</u>. The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 176.4 cpl, 13.2 cpl lower than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).



Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 202.8 cpl. This was an increase of 3.6 cpl from the previous month, however 13.2 cpl lower over the year (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 183.2 cpl, an increase of 3.3 cpl from the previous month, however 13.0 cpl lower over the year.


Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 178.3 cpl, 5.5 cpl higher than the previous month, however 15.7 cpl lower over the year. Darwin had the second lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 176.4 cpl in Perth to 193.5 cpl in Canberra (Chart 5).

The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 173.9 cpl, 2.9 cpl higher than last month, however 4.9 cpl lower over the year. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel increased by 2.7 cpl to 4.4 cpl (Chart 6). This was the lowest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 8.4 cpl in Perth to 15.6 cpl in Melbourne.


Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in December 2024 was \$117.34 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was an increase of 5.1% in the month and an increase of 1.7% over the year.
















GIRD Retail price (labelled) *No fuel import terminal in Canberra Source: Australian Insitute of Petroleum, DTF





terminal and provide an indication of the actual wholesale price of fuel. The largest component of the TGP is the price of crude oil, followed by the Commonwealth Government's fuel excise and goods and services tax.

4 Gross indicative retail differences (GIRD) are equal to the monthly average retail price less the monthly average TGP and are used as a broad indication of gross retail fuel margins.

Term	Definition
Gross Indicative Retail Differences (GIRDs)	Gross indicative retail differences are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.
Terminal Gate Price (TGP)	Terminal gate price is the wholesale price for the bulk supply of a petroleum product.
