Fuel prices

April 2025 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for April 2025 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 27 April 2025 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in the Territory was 194.8 cpl, 1.6 cpl lower than the previous month and 13.2 cpl lower over the year (Chart 1). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 178.7 cpl, 2.8 cpl lower than the previous month and 27.7 cpl lower over the year.

In Darwin, the average ULP price was 180.0 cpl, 1.6 cpl lower than the previous month and 15.3 cpl lower over the year. This was the second highest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 172 cpl in Perth to 187.9 cpl in Melbourne (Chart 2).

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 163.7 cpl, 4.8 cpl lower than the previous month and 27.8 cpl lower over the year. The average TGP nationally was 159.1 cpl, 4.9 cpl lower than the previous month and 29.1 cpl lower over the year.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin increased by 3.2 cpl to 16.3 cpl (Chart 3). This was the third highest GIRD of the capital cities, which ranged from 13.6 cpl in Perth to 28.5 cpl in Melbourne. The national average GIRD for ULP increased by 2.1 cpl to 19.6 cpl in the month

ACCC fuel price monitoring


The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the December quarter 2024 on 25 February 2025. The Report can be accessed here. The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 168.9 cpl, 10.9 cpl lower than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average)





Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 206.9 cpl. This was a decrease of 1.3 cpl from the previous month and 13.1 cpl lower over the year (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 184.7 cpl, a decrease of 3.2 cpl from the previous month and 17.4 cpl lower over the year.


Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 184.6 cpl, 1.4 cpl lower than the previous month and 14.7 cpl lower over the year. Darwin had the third highest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 179.4 cpl in Perth to 193.4 cpl in Canberra (Chart 5).


The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 167.8 cpl, 4.9 cpl lower than last month and 21.4 cpl lower over the year. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel increased by 3.5 cpl to 16.8 cpl (Chart 6). This was the second lowest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 16.7 cpl in Sydney to 22.3 cpl in Brisbane.

Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in April 2025 was \$102.68 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was a decrease of 9.4% in the month and a decrease of 24.0% over the year.





Term	Definition
Gross Indicative Retail Differences (GIRDs)	Gross indicative retail differences are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.
Terminal Gate Price (TGP)	Terminal gate price is the wholesale price for the bulk supply of a petroleum product.
