# **Fuel prices**

## September 2022 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for September 2022 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 2 October 2022 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in Darwin was 175.7 cpl, 12.1 cpl lower than the previous month, however 23.9 cpl higher in annual terms (Chart 1). Darwin had the second highest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 163.9 cpl in Adelaide to 178.8 cpl in Canberra (Chart 2). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 171.3 cpl, 1.6 cpl lower than the previous month, however 16.5 cpl higher in annual terms.

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 153.5 cpl, 4.3 cpl lower than the previous month, however 10.0 cpl higher in annual terms. The average TGP nationally was 152.8 cpl, 2.7 cpl lower than the previous month, however 13.9 cpl higher in annual terms.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin decreased by 7.9 cpl to 22.1 cpl in the month (Chart 3). This was the second highest GIRD of the capital cities, which ranged from 9.9 cpl in Adelaide to 22.6 cpl in Brisbane. The national average GIRD for ULP increased by 1.2 cpl to 18.5 cpl in the month.

# **ACCC** fuel price monitoring

The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the June quarter 2022 on 5 September 2022. The Report can be accessed here.

The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 194.8 cpl, 6.8 cpl higher than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average) cpl 240 220 200 180 160 140 120 100 Australia 80 60





#### **Diesel**

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 224.4 cpl. This was a decrease of 1.5 cpl from the previous month, however 59.0 cpl higher in annual terms (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 205.5 cpl, an increase of 3.3 cpl from the previous month and 56.5 cpl higher in annual terms.

Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 209.2 cpl, 3.4 cpl lower than the previous month, however 55.0 cpl higher in annual terms. Darwin had the third highest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 198.1 cpl in Perth to 211.7 cpl in Hobart (Chart 5).

The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 188.9 cpl, 3.0 cpl higher than last month and 47.7 cpl higher in annual terms. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel decreased by 6.4 cpl to 20.3 cpl in the month. This was the highest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 9.0 cpl in Adelaide to 16.8 cpl in Hobart. The national average GIRD for diesel decreased by 0.9 cpl to 16.6 cpl in the month (Chart 6).

#### Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in September 2022 was \$134.36 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was a decrease of 4.0% in the month and an increase of 30.1% in annual terms.

Chart 4: Retail diesel price (monthly average)




Chart 5: Diesel price and gross indicative retail difference (monthly average)
