### Residential building approvals

In September 2022, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 4.4% to 71, the second strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 19.2% in the Australian Capital Territory to an increase of 5.6% in New South Wales. Nationally, residential building approvals increased by 1.9%.

In annual terms, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 129.0%. This was the strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 36.8% in the Australian Capital Territory to an increase of 6.0% in Tasmania. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 7.0%.

In the year to September 2022, residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 15.7% to 626, compared with a decrease of 17.0% to 193,370 nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the fourth strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 38.1% in Western Australia to an increase of 9.1% in the Australian Capital Territory, the only jurisdiction to report an increase (Chart 2). House approvals decreased by 32.2%, unit and townhouse approvals increased by 81.8%, and alterations, additions and conversions approvals increased by 392.9% from 14 to 69.


In the year to September 2022, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 10.1% to \$359.9 million, compared with a decrease of 3.1% to \$88.4 billion nationally.

## Non-residential approvals


In September 2022, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 20.1% to \$45.4 million, reflecting a decrease of 50.8% in private non-residential building approvals, partly offset by an increase of 13.6% in public non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals decreased by 9.7% to \$4.7 billion.

Chart 1: Number of residential building approvals (moving annual total, original)




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Chart 2: Number of residential building approvals (year-on-year percentage change)
