In May 2023, trend resident employment in the Territory increased by 0.6% to 144,334 persons. Part-time employment increased by 1.1% and full-time employment increased by 0.5%. Nationally, employment increased by 0.3%, with full-time employment increasing by 0.3% and part-time employment increasing by 0.2%.

Annually, trend resident employment increased by 6.2% in the Territory. Nationally, employment increased by 3.1% over the same period (Chart 1). In the year to May 2023, Territory employment increased by 4.0% on a year-on-year basis, reflecting an increase in full-time employment of 5.1% and an increase in part-time employment of 0.3%. Nationally, year-on-year employment increased by 4.3%.



The Territory's trend unemployment rate increased from 3.4% in April 2023 to 3.6% in May 2023 (Chart 2). Nationally, the monthly unemployment rate was flat at 3.5%.



The trend participation rate in the Territory increased by 0.3 percentage points to 76.2% in May 2023. The Territory's participation rate is the highest of the jurisdictions, and well above the national rate of 66.8% (Chart 3).




