

Fuel prices

November 2024 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for November 2024 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 01 December 2024 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in the Territory was 186.5 cpl, 1.5 cpl lower than the previous month and 24.3 cpl lower over the year (Chart 1). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 177.2 cpl, 0.4 cpl lower than the previous month and 20.7 cpl lower over the year.

In Darwin, the average ULP price was 168.5 cpl, 1.6 cpl lower than the previous month and 29.3 cpl lower over the year. This was the lowest retail price of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 170.2 cpl in Adelaide to 181 cpl in Sydney (Chart 2).

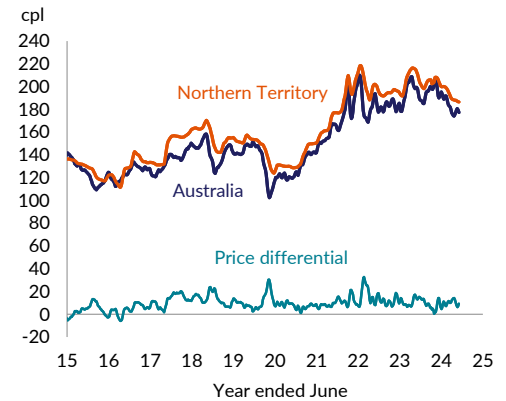
The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 166.6 cpl, 0.3 cpl higher than the previous month and 14.5 cpl lower over the year. The average TGP nationally was 162.2 cpl, 0.1 cpl higher than the previous month and 14.3 cpl lower over the year.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin declined by 1.9 cpl to 1.9 cpl (Chart 3). This was the lowest GIRD of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 7.9 cpl in Adelaide to 19.1 cpl in Sydney. The national average GIRD for ULP declined by 0.6 cpl to 15.0 cpl in the month.

ACCC fuel price monitoring

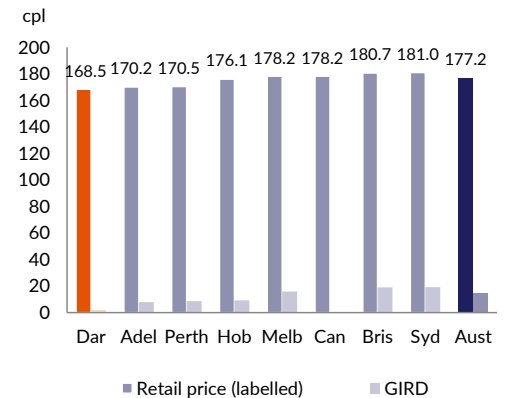
The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the September quarter 2024 on 27 November 2024. The Report can be accessed [here](#). The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 176.4 cpl, 6.4 cpl lower than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average)



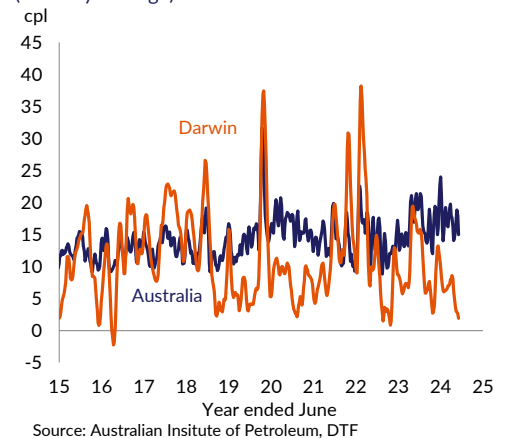

Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 199.2 cpl. This was a decline of 1.8 cpl from the previous month and 29.7 cpl lower over the year (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 179.5 cpl, an increase of 0.6 cpl from the previous month and 32.4 cpl lower over the year.

Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 172.8 cpl, 1.8 cpl lower than the previous month and 38.4 cpl lower over the year. Darwin had the second lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 171.2 cpl in Perth to 187.8 cpl in Canberra (Chart 5).

The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 170.7 cpl, 3.2 cpl higher than last month and 19.3 cpl lower over the year. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel declined by 4.9 cpl to 2.1 cpl (Chart 6). This was the lowest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 6.4 cpl in Perth to 14.2 cpl in Brisbane.

Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in November 2024 was \$111.98 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was a decline of 0.4% in the month and a decline of 10.4% over the year.

Chart 7: Brent crude oil prices (monthly average)

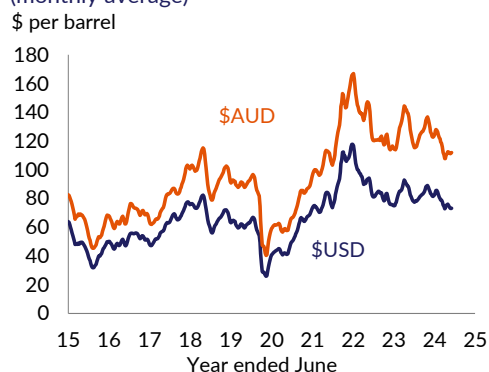


Chart 4: Retail diesel price (monthly average)

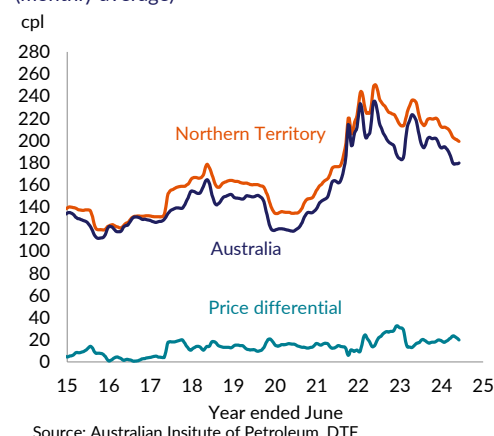


Chart 5: Diesel price and gross indicative retail difference (monthly average)

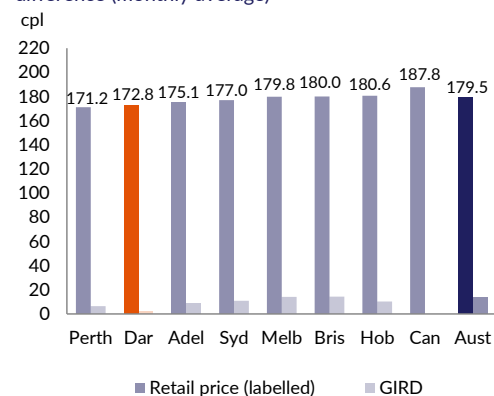


Chart 6: Diesel gross indicative retail difference (monthly average)

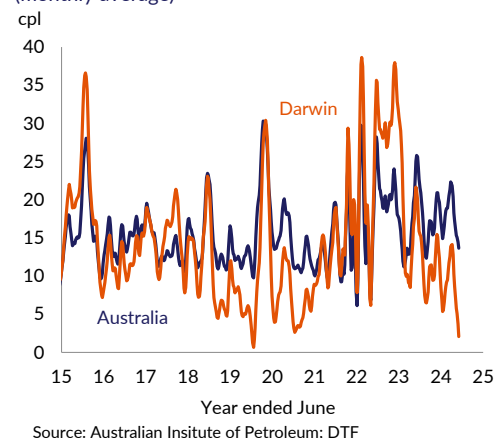

terminal and provide an indication of the actual wholesale price of fuel. The largest component of the TGP is the price of crude oil, followed by the Commonwealth Government's fuel excise and goods and services tax.

Term	Definition
Gross Indicative Retail Differences (GIRDs)	Gross indicative retail differences are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.
Terminal Gate Price (TGP)	Terminal gate price is the wholesale price for the bulk supply of a petroleum product.
