Fuel prices

March 2025 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for March 2025 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 30 March 2025 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in the Territory was 196.7 cpl, 0.2 cpl lower than the previous month and 9.1 cpl lower over the year (Chart 1). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 182.6 cpl, 1.9 cpl lower than the previous month and 17.1 cpl lower over the year.

In Darwin, the average ULP price was 181.8 cpl, 0.1 cpl lower than the previous month and 9.9 cpl lower over the year. This was the fourth lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 173.8 cpl in Adelaide to 194.1 cpl in Brisbane (Chart 2).

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 168.7 cpl, 6.0 cpl lower than the previous month and 16.2 cpl lower over the year. The average TGP nationally was 164.2 cpl, 5.7 cpl lower than the previous month and 17.8 cpl lower over the year.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin increased by 5.9 cpl to 13.1 cpl (Chart 3). This was the fourth highest GIRD of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 9.6 cpl in Adelaide to 30.5 cpl in Brisbane. The national average GIRD for ULP increased by 3.9 cpl to 18.4 cpl in the month

ACCC fuel price monitoring


The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the December quarter 2024 on 25 February 2025. The Report can be accessed here. The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 168.9 cpl, 10.9 cpl lower than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average)





Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 208.4 cpl. This was a decline of 1.9 cpl from the previous month and 11.1 cpl lower over the year (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 188.8 cpl, a decline of 2.4 cpl from the previous month and 13.2 cpl lower over the year.

Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 186.4 cpl, 2.6 cpl lower than the previous month and 12.9 cpl lower over the year. Darwin had the fourth lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 182.2 cpl in Adelaide to 195.7 cpl in Canberra (Chart 5).

The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 173.1 cpl, 6.2 cpl lower than last month and 14.8 cpl lower over the year. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel increased by 3.5 cpl to 13.2 cpl (Chart 6). This was the equal lowest of the capital cities with Adelaide, which otherwise ranged from 15.4 cpl in Perth to 22.5 cpl in Brisbane.

Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in March 2025 was \$112.75 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was a decline of 5.0% in the month and a decline of 12.8% over the year.




Chart 6: Diesel gross indicative retail difference (monthly average)



Term	Definition
Gross Indicative Retail Differences (GIRDs)	Gross indicative retail differences are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.
Terminal Gate Price (TGP)	Terminal gate price is the wholesale price for the bulk supply of a petroleum product.
