Fuel prices

March 2023 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for March 2023 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 02 April 2023 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in Darwin was 179.7 cpl, 1.0 cpl higher than the previous month, however 25.9 cpl lower in annual terms (Chart 1). Darwin had the second lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 178.0 cpl in Perth to 188.4 cpl in Hobart (Chart 2). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 182.9 cpl, 3.8 cpl lower than the previous month and 19.7 cpl lower in annual terms.

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 176.5 cpl, 1.4 cpl higher than the previous month, however 12.6 cpl lower in annual terms. The average TGP nationally was 173.0 cpl, 1.5 cpl higher than the previous month, however 13.1 cpl lower in annual terms.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin decreased by 0.4 cpl to 3.2 cpl in the month (Chart 3). This was the lowest GIRD of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 6.6 cpl in Perth to 13.5 cpl in Sydney. The national average GIRD for ULP decreased by 5.3 cpl to 9.9 cpl in the month.

ACCC fuel price monitoring

The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the December quarter 2022 on 24 March 2023. The Report can be accessed here.


The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 183.8 cpl, 1.1 cpl higher than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average)





Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 225.1 cpl. This was a decrease of 3.4 cpl from the previous month, however 4.8 cpl higher in annual terms (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 197.9 cpl, a decrease of 3.4 cpl from the previous month and 16.6 cpl lower in annual terms.


Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 209.8 cpl, 3.8 cpl lower than the previous month and 8.3 cpl lower in annual terms. Darwin had the highest retail price of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 186.7 cpl in Perth to 207.3 cpl in Hobart (Chart 5).


The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 181.7 cpl, 1.9 cpl lower than last month and 17.0 cpl lower in annual terms. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel decreased by 2.0 cpl to 28.1 cpl in the month. This was the highest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 10.2 cpl in Perth to 24.6 cpl in Hobart (Chart 6).

Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in March 2023 was \$117.32 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was a decrease of 4.2% in the month and a decrease of 22.8% in annual terms.


