Fuel prices

October 2024 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for October 2024 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 03 November 2024 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in the Territory was 188.0 cpl, 0.7 cpl lower than the previous month and 27.9 cpl lower over the year (Chart 1). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 177.6 cpl, 2.1 cpl higher than the previous month and 21.4 cpl lower over the year.

In Darwin, the average ULP price was 170.1 cpl, 0.5 cpl lower than the previous month and 34.4 cpl lower over the year. This was the lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 173 cpl in Perth to 185 cpl in Brisbane (Chart 2).

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 166.3 cpl, 4.3 cpl higher than the previous month and 18.7 cpl lower over the year. The average TGP nationally was 162.1 cpl, 4.3 cpl higher than the previous month and 19.0 cpl lower over the year.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin declined by 4.8 cpl to 3.8 cpl (Chart 3). This was the lowest GIRD of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 9 cpl in Hobart to 23.3 cpl in Brisbane. The national average GIRD for ULP declined by 2.1 cpl to 15.6 cpl in the month.

ACCC fuel price monitoring


The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the June quarter 2024 on 24 September 2024. The Report can be accessed here. The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 189.6 cpl, 6.9 cpl lower than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average)





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Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 201.0 cpl. This was a decline of 2.2 cpl from the previous month and 35.2 cpl lower over the year (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 178.9 cpl, a decline of 1.0 cpl from the previous month and 42.4 cpl lower over the year.

Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 174.6 cpl, 2.3 cpl lower than the previous month and 46.7 cpl lower over the year. Darwin had the third lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 170.1 cpl in Perth to 187.2 cpl in Canberra (Chart 5).

The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 167.5 cpl, 4.7 cpl higher than last month and 37.4 cpl lower over the year. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel declined by 7.1 cpl to 7.0 cpl (Chart 6). This was the lowest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 8.5 cpl in Perth to 17.1 cpl in Brisbane.

Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in October 2024 was \$112.39 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was an increase of 4.2% in the month and a decline of 19.3% over the year.






Term	Definition
Gross Indicative Retail Differences (GIRDs)	Gross indicative retail differences are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.
Terminal Gate Price (TGP)	Terminal gate price is the wholesale price for the bulk supply of a petroleum product.
