Vendor (company) declaration of new residence

BuildBonus was introduced by the Northern Territory Government on 8 February 2019 to encourage construction of new homes.

BuildBonus provides a \$20 000 grant to home buyers that sign a contract to purchase a new home after 8 February 2019 provided construction of the home also commenced after that date.

The application for BuildBonus is required to be supported by a declaration from the vendor confirming that the home is new.

For the purpose of BuildBonus, a new home is a home (including off the plan purchases) that has never been previously sold or occupied as a place of residence, including occupation by the builder, a tenant or other occupant.

A home is not a new home if construction of the home commenced prior to 8 February 2019.

Commencement of construction means:

- for a new home, laying of the foundations
- for a new home that is a unit in a unit development, the earlier of laying of the foundations or the laying of a slab for a carpark,

but does not include site clearing.

Commencement of construction can be evidenced by the following:

- an invoice for laying of the foundations/a car park slab that shows the date this occurred
- or an inspection certificate for the foundations or slab prepared by a licensed building certifier.

An applicant is **NOT** eligible to claim BuildBonus if:

- the contract (the subject of the application) replaces a contract made before 8 February 2019 to purchase the same or a substantially similar home
- or in purchasing a new home, the purchaser had an option to purchase the home granted before 8 February 2019 or the vendor had an option to require the purchaser to purchase the home which was granted before 8 February 2019.

OATHS, AFFIDAVITS AND DECLARATIONS ACT

STATUTORY DECLARATION

1. I have carefully read, and understood, the terms and conditions of the BuildBonus scheme set out on the back of this statutory declaration.

 - (c) did not arise from an option granted to me before 8 February 2019 under which I required the buyer to enter into that agreement.
6. Construction of the home commenced on .
7. Attached to this declaration is evidence of the construction commencement date referred to in paragraph 6 above (attach invoice for laying of foundations/slab, building certifier certificate, etc.) .
8. This is the first time the home has, or will have, been sold.
9. The home has never been previously occupied as a place of residence, including occupation by the builder, a tenant or other occupant.
10. To my knowledge, BuildBonus has not been paid and is not payable to any person other than the buyer in relation to this residence.

This declaration is true and I know it is an offence to make a declaration knowing it is false in a material particular.
