Building approvals

December 2021 | Economic brief

Residential building approvals

In December 2021, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 31.7% to 28, the lowest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 23.9% in Queensland to an increase of 136.5% in the Australian Capital Territory. The decrease reflects a decrease in house approvals, down from 39 to 28. Nationally residential building approvals decreased by 6.0% in the month.

Through the year, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 60.0%, reflecting lower house approvals, down from 63 to 28. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 6.9%.

In year-on-year terms, residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 8.7% to 638, compared with an increase of 22.5% nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the only decrease of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from an increase of 11.5% in Tasmania to an increase of 37.5% in Western Australia (Chart 2). House approvals increased by 13.7%, unit and townhouse approvals decreased by 67.3%, and alterations, additions and conversions approvals decreased by 65.4%.


In 2021, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 7.9% to \$375 million, compared with an increase of 29.3% to \$91.4 billion nationally.


In December 2021, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 617.6% to \$317 million, reflecting a 941.6% increase in public non-residential building approvals, partly offset by a 2.6% decrease in private non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals decreased by 15.5% to \$4.2 billion.

Chart 1: Number of residential building approvals (moving annual total, original)




