Residential building approvals

In August 2023, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 5.4% to 35, the weakest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 4.7% in New South Wales to an increase of 18.4% in the Australian Capital Territory. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 0.4%.

In annual terms, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 47.8%. This was the weakest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 23.7% in Queensland to a decrease of 3.2% in the Australian Capital Territory. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 15.8%.

In the year to August 2023, residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 20.5% to 497, compared with a decrease of 12.9% to 170,345 nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the third weakest result of the jurisdictions, which ranged from a decrease of 32.1% in the Australian Capital Territory to a decrease of 5.9% in South Australia (Chart 2). Alterations, additions and conversions approvals decreased by 91.7% (from 72 to 6), unit and townhouse approvals decreased by 48.0%, and house approvals decreased by 3.1%.


In the year to August 2023, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 6.3% to \$336.1 million, compared with a decrease of 0.1% to \$88.2 billion nationally.


In August 2023, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 42.9% to \$27.1 million, reflecting a decrease of 76.5% in private non-residential building approvals, partly offset by an increase of 437.8% in public non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals increased by 21.9% to \$7.0 billion.

Chart 1: Number of residential building approvals (moving annual total, original)




