## Fuel prices

## May 2024 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for May 2024 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 02 June 2024 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in the Territory was $206.1 \mathrm{cpl}, 1.9 \mathrm{cpl}$ lower than the previous month, however 9.7 cpl higher in annual terms (Chart 1). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 191.8 cpl, 14.6 cpl lower than the previous month, however 13.1 cpl higher in annual terms.

In Darwin, the average ULP price was $193.3 \mathrm{cpl}, 2.0 \mathrm{cpl}$ lower than the previous month, however 11.6 cpl higher in annual terms. This was the fourth highest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 182.8 cpl in Adelaide to 205.6 cpl in Canberra (Chart 2).

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 180.2 cpl, 11.3 cpl lower than the previous month, however 11.1 cpl higher in annual terms. The average TGP nationally was $176.8 \mathrm{cpl}, 11.4 \mathrm{cpl}$ lower than the previous month, however 10.8 cpl higher in annual terms.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin increased by 9.4 cpl to 13.1 cpl (Chart 3). This was the fourth lowest GIRD of the capital cities, which ranged from 5.5 cpl in Adelaide to 19.4 cpl in Hobart. The national average GIRD decreased by 3.3 cpl to 15.0 cpl in the month.

## ACCC fuel price monitoring

The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the December quarter 2023 on 19 March 2024. The Report can be accessed here. The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was $195.6 \mathrm{cpl}, 0.7 \mathrm{cpl}$ lower than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

## Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 217.5 cpl . This was a decrease of 2.5 cpl from the previous month and 1.6 cpl lower in annual terms (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 197.7 cpl , a decrease of 4.4 cpl from the previous month, however 11.3 cpl higher in annual terms.

Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 195.4 cpl , 3.9 cpl lower than the previous month and 9.7 cpl lower in annual terms. Darwin had the fourth lowest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 189.0 cpl in Perth to 206.8 cpl in Canberra (Chart 5).

The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 180.2 cpl, 9.0 cpl lower than last month, however 12.2 cpl higher in annual terms. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel increased by 5.0 cpl to 15.1 cpl (Chart 6). This was the third lowest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 13.9 cpl in Adelaide to 21.3 cpl in Brisbane.

## Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in May 2024 was $\$ 125.13$ per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was a decrease of $7.3 \%$ in the month and an increase of $9.4 \%$ in annual terms.

terminal and provide an indication of the actual wholesale price of fuel. The largest component of the TGP is the price of crude oil, followed by the Commonwealth Government's fuel excise and goods and services tax.
4 Gross indicative retail differences (GIRD) are equal to the monthly average retail price less the monthly average TGP and are used as a broad indication of gross retail fuel margins.

* AIP does not report on diesel prices for Alice Springs, Katherine and Tennant Creek.
