The following table outlines agencies with construction authority status, and any exceptions or limitations to the Treasurer's Direction – Infrastructure:

Agency	Exceptions / limitations
Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL)	<p><b>Procurement</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DIPL may procure and manage capital works and repairs and maintenance projects for any agency.</li> </ul>
Land Development Corporation (LDC)	<p><b>Procurement</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• LDC may procure and manage its own capital works and repairs and maintenance projects.</li> </ul> <p><b>Minor works projects or variations outside the Budget development process</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• LDC may self-administer self-funded variations to its minor works program by up to an aggregate of \$1 000 000 within a financial year, with notification to the Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF).</li> </ul> <p><b>Repairs and maintenance projects or variations outside the Budget development process</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• LDC may self-administer self-funded variations to its repairs and maintenance program by up to an aggregate of \$1 000 000 within a financial year, with notification to DTF.</li> </ul>
