# **Employment**

In June 2023, trend resident employment in the Territory decreased by 0.1% to 141,140 persons. Part-time employment decreased by 0.4%, while full-time employment was flat. Nationally, employment increased by 0.3%, with full-time employment increasing by 0.4% and part-time employment increasing by 0.1%.

Annually, trend resident employment increased by 3.6% in the Territory. Nationally, employment increased by 3.1% over the same period (Chart 1). In 2022-23, Territory employment increased by 4.0%, reflecting an increase in full-time employment of 4.9% and an increase in part-time employment of 1.0%. Nationally, year-on-year employment increased by 4.2%.

The Territory's trend unemployment rate was flat at 3.3% in the month of June 2023 (Chart 2). Nationally, the monthly unemployment rate was flat at 3.5%.

The trend participation rate in the Territory decreased by 0.3 percentage points to 74.3% in June 2023. The Territory's participation rate is the highest of the jurisdictions, and well above the national rate of 66.8% (Chart 3).


