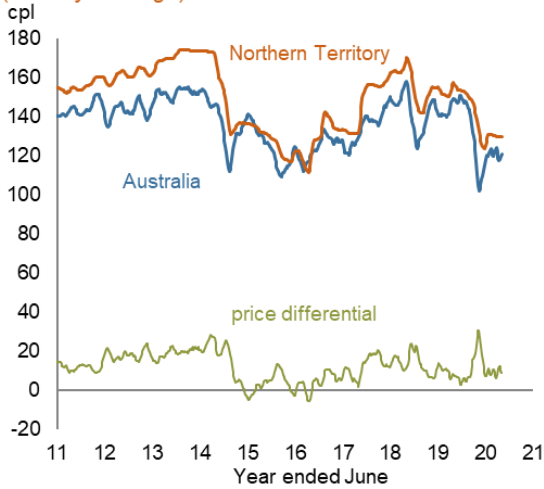

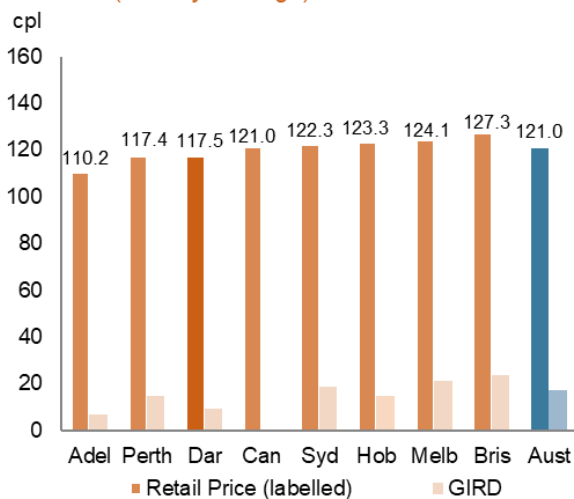

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average)



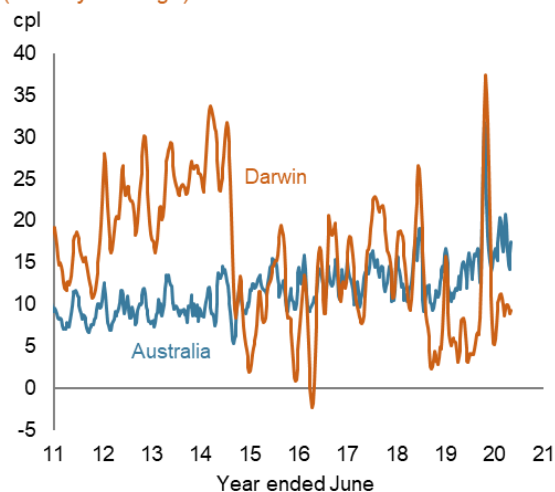

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for October 2020 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 1 November 2020 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in Darwin was 117.5 cpl, 0.1 cpl lower than the previous month and 29.3 cpl lower in annual terms (Chart 1). Darwin had the third lowest monthly retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 110.2 cpl in Adelaide to 127.3 cpl in Brisbane (Chart 2). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 121.0 cpl, 2.0 cpl higher than the previous month but 28.4 cpl lower in annual terms.

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin increased by 0.6 cpl to 108.2 cpl in the month, but is 30.3 cpl lower in annual terms. This was in-line with the national average TGP monthly change, up by 0.8 cpl to 103.5 cpl, but down by 31.0 cpl compared with last year.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin decreased by 0.8 cpl to 9.2 cpl in the month (Chart 3). This was the second lowest GIRD of the capital cities, which ranged from 6.8 cpl in Adelaide to 23.7 cpl in Brisbane. The national average GIRD for ULP increased by 1.2 cpl to 17.5 cpl in the month.

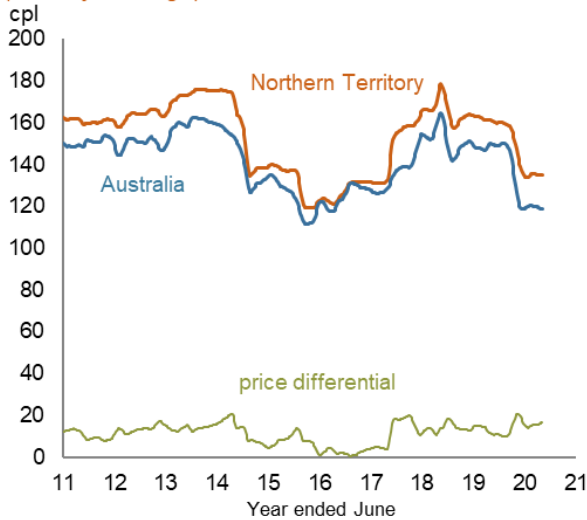
ACCC fuel price monitoring

The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the June quarter 2020 on 2 September 2020. The Report can be accessed [here](#).

The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 116.0 cpl, 7.0 cpl higher than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

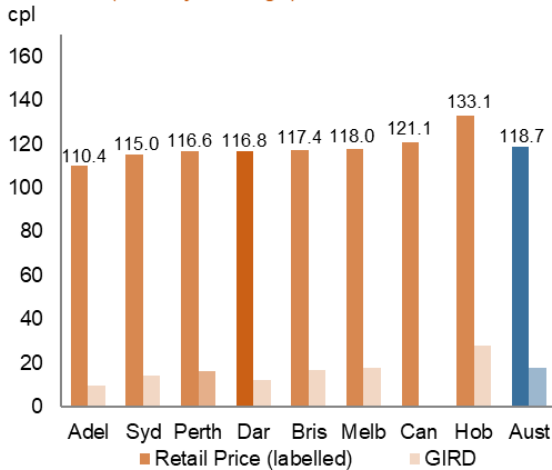

Chart 4: Retail diesel price (monthly average)



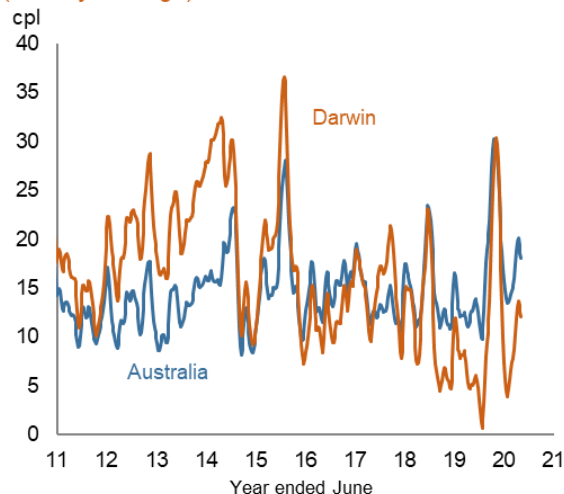

Diesel

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 135.1 cpl. This was flat from the previous month, and 26.0 cpl lower in annual terms (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price differential between the Territory and the national average was 16.4 cpl.

Darwin recorded the fourth lowest retail price for diesel of the capital cities, with a monthly average retail price of 116.8 cpl. This was a monthly decrease of 0.1 cpl, and a decline of 28.8 cpl in annual terms. The monthly average retail price ranged from 110.4 cpl in Adelaide to 133.1 cpl in Hobart (Chart 5). Nationally, the average price of diesel decreased by 0.7 cpl to 118.7 cpl in the month, and decreased by 31.2 cpl in annual terms.

The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 104.7 cpl, 0.9 cpl higher than last month and 35.8 cpl lower than last year.

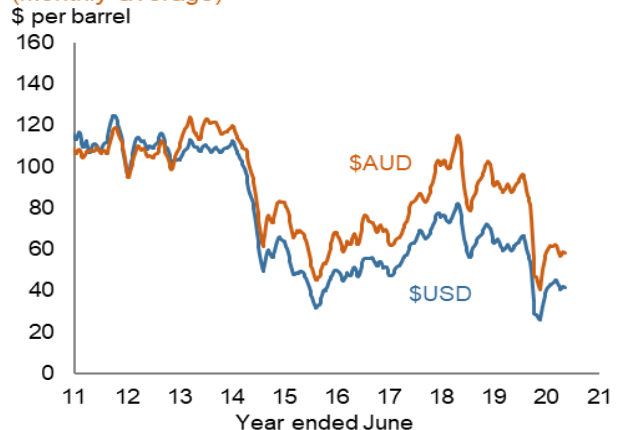
Darwin's average GIRD for diesel was 12.1 cpl, the second lowest of the capital cities. This was a monthly decrease of 1.0 cpl, and was 5.9 cpl lower than the national average of 18.0 cpl (Chart 6).

Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in October 2020 was \$58.42 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was an increase of 3.5 per cent in the month, but a decrease of 33.7 per cent in annual terms.

3 Terminal gate prices (TGPs) are the published daily spot prices at which fuel can be purchased from the fuel import or refinery terminal and provide an indication of the actual wholesale price of fuel. The largest component of the TGP is the price of crude oil, followed by the Commonwealth Government's fuel excise and goods and services tax.

4 Gross indicative retail differences (GIRD) are equal to the monthly average retail price less the monthly average TGP and are used as a broad indication of gross retail fuel margins.

* AIP does not report on diesel prices for Alice Springs, Katherine and Tennant Creek.
