Residential building approvals

In May 2023, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 2.3% to 44, the second strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 32.7% in the Australian Capital Territory to an increase of 11.2% in New South Wales. Nationally, residential building approvals increased by 0.8%.

In annual terms, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 25.4%. This was the fourth weakest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 70.7% in the Australian Capital Territory to an increase of 13.7% in New South Wales. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 15.8%.

In the year to May 2023, residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 17.7% to 618, compared with a decrease of 12.7% to 178,392 nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 29.7% in the Australian Capital Territory to a decrease of 3.4% in Tasmania (Chart 2). House approvals increased by 35.0%, unit and townhouse approvals increased by 26.5%, and alterations, additions and conversions approvals decreased by 84.5% from 71 to 11.


In the year to May 2023, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 29.2% to \$393.6 million, compared with an increase of 1.7% to \$89.8 billion nationally.


In May 2023, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 353.3% to \$309.3 million, reflecting an increase of 866.2% in public non-residential building approvals, partly offset by a decrease of 25.9% in private non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals increased by 60.2% to \$8.4 billion.

Chart 3: Territory residential building approvals


