### March 2023 | Economic brief

## Residential building approvals

In March 2023, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 5.0% to 42, the strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 13.3% in the Australian Capital Territory to an increase of 0.5% in Western Australia. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 3.7%.

In annual terms, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 22.2%. This was the fourth strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 42.0% in the Australian Capital Territory to an increase of 6.6% in Queensland. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 21.5%.

In the year to March 2023, residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 3.6% to 604, compared with a decrease of 15.6% to 181,544 nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 26.5% in Western Australia to a decrease of 6.3% in South Australia (Chart 2). House approvals increased by 20.0%, unit and townhouse approvals decreased by 6.9%, and alterations, additions and conversions approvals decreased by 82.9%.


In the year to March 2023, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 17.2% to \$375.7 million, compared with a decrease of 1.2% to \$88.9 billion nationally.


In March 2023, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 12.8% to \$45.4 million, reflecting a decrease of 33.6% in public non-residential building approvals, partly offset by an increase of 36.5% in private non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals decreased by 8.2% to \$5.3 billion.

Chart 1: Number of residential building approvals (moving annual total, original)




