In December 2023, trend resident employment in the Territory increased by 0.1% to 138,236 persons. Part-time employment increased by 0.8% while full-time employment was flat. Nationally, employment increased by 0.1%, with part-time employment increasing by 0.5% while full-time employment was flat.

Annually, trend resident employment decreased by 1.0% in the Territory. Nationally, employment increased by 3.0% over the same period (Chart 1). In 2023, Territory employment increased by 2.7%, reflecting an increase in full-time employment of 3.4% and an increase in part-time employment of 0.2%. Nationally, year-on-year employment increased by 3.3%.


The Territory's trend unemployment rate increased from 4.5% in November 2023 to 4.6% in December 2023 (Chart 2). Nationally, the monthly unemployment rate was flat at 3.8%.


The trend participation rate in the Territory increased by 0.1 percentage points to 73.3% in December 2023. The Territory's participation rate is the highest of the jurisdictions, and well above the national rate of 67.0% (Chart 3).
