Residential building approvals

In October 2023, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 2.8% to 37, the third strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 4.9% in New South Wales to an increase of 12.3% in the Australian Capital Territory. Nationally, residential building approvals increased by 0.3%.

In annual terms, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 33.9%. This was the weakest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 26.5% in New South Wales to an increase of 3.6% in Western Australia. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 12.7%.

In the year to October 2023, residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 27.5% to 473, compared with a decrease of 13.8% to 166,177 nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the second weakest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease of 30.1% in the Australian Capital Territory to a decrease of 7.0% in South Australia (Chart 2). Alterations, additions and conversions approvals decreased by 95.9% from 73 to 3, unit and townhouse approvals decreased by 51.1%, and house approvals decreased by 12.6%.


In the year to October 2023, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 1.9% to \$367.7 million, compared with a decrease of 3.0% to \$86.9 billion nationally.


In October 2023, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 189.9% to \$103.3 million, reflecting an increase of 364.6% in private non-residential building approvals, partly offset by a decrease of 79.0% in public non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals increased by 11.4% to \$5.8 billion.

Chart 1: Number of residential building approvals (moving annual total, original)




