



Chart 1: Number of residential building approvals (moving annual total, original)





Residential building approvals

In June 2021, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 13.3% to 52, the third largest decrease of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a 31.3% decrease in Western Australian to a 31.3% increase in the Australian Capital Territory. The monthly decrease was largely due to a fall in unit and townhouse approvals, which were down from 19 to 2 in the month. Nationally residential building approvals decreased by 6.8% in the month.

In year-on-year terms, residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 36.7% to 797 and increased by 26.3% nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the second largest increase of the jurisdictions, behind Western Australia (up by 87.3%) (Chart 2). In 2020-21, house approvals in the Territory increased by 77.1%, unit and townhouse approvals decreased by 59.2%, and alterations, additions and conversions approvals increased by 43.8%.

In 2020-21, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 19.1% to \$410 million. Nationally, the total value of residential building approvals increased by 27.9% to \$84 billion.

Non-residential building approvals

In June 2021, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 48.5% to \$34 million, reflecting a 198.1% increase in the value of public non-residential building approvals, partly offset by an 8.0% decrease in the value of private non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals decreased by 7.9% to \$4.9 billion.
