Residential building approvals

In June 2022, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 5.9% to 48, the weakest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease 2.7% in the Australian Capital Territory to an increase of 5.5% in Western Australia. Nationally, residential building approvals were flat.

Through the year to June 2022, the number of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 9.4%. This was the third strongest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease 27.9% in New South Wales to an increase of 61.2% in the Australian Capital Territory. Nationally, residential building approvals decreased by 19.7%.

In 2021-22, residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 33.5% to 529, compared with a decrease of 9.4% to 201,306 nationally (Chart 1). The Territory reported the weakest result of the jurisdictions, which otherwise ranged from a decrease 29.4% in Western Australia to an increase of 21.2% in the Australian Capital Territory (Chart 2). House approvals decreased by 45.0% while unit and townhouse approvals increased by 2.9%, and alterations, additions and conversions approvals increased by 233.3%

In 2021-22, the value of residential building approvals in the Territory decreased by 24.7% to \$308.3 million, compared with an increase of 3.4% to \$88.1 billion nationally.

Non-residential approvals

In June 2022, the value of non-residential building approvals in the Territory increased by 2.9% to \$29.8 million, reflecting an increase of 66.7% in private non-residential building approvals, offset by a decrease of 60.8% in public non-residential building approvals. Nationally, the value of non-residential building approvals decreased by 17.3% to \$5.3 billion.

Chart 1: Number of residential building approvals (moving annual total, original)






Chart 2: Number of residential building approvals (year-on-year percentage change)
