# **Fuel prices**

## August 2022 | Economic brief

The following information is sourced from the Australian Institute of Petroleum (AIP) and the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

The reported monthly average price for August 2022 is calculated as the average price in cents per litre (cpl) for the four weeks ending 04 September 2022 unless otherwise stated.

Gross indicative retail differences (GIRDs) are the average retail price less the published terminal gate prices (TGP) and are used as an indication of gross retail margins.

The average retail price of ULP in Darwin was 187.8 cpl, 16.4 cpl lower than the previous month, however 36.1 cpl higher in annual terms (Chart 1). Darwin had the highest retail price of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 163.4 cpl in Adelaide to 185.2 cpl in Canberra (Chart 2). Nationally, the average retail price of ULP was 172.9 cpl, 15.2 cpl lower than the previous month, however 20.7 cpl higher in annual terms.

The average TGP for ULP in Darwin was 157.8 cpl, 10.3 cpl lower than the previous month, however 15.9 cpl higher in annual terms. The average TGP nationally was 155.5 cpl, 10.6 cpl lower than the previous month, however 18.3 cpl higher in annual terms.

The monthly average GIRD for ULP in Darwin decreased by 6.1 cpl to 30.0 cpl in the month (Chart 3). This was the highest GIRD of the capital cities, which ranged from 7.0 cpl in Adelaide to 21.7 cpl in Brisbane. The national average GIRD for ULP decreased by 4.7 cpl to 17.3 cpl in the month.

# **ACCC** fuel price monitoring

The ACCC released its Report on the Australian Petroleum Market for the June quarter 2022 on 5 September 2022. The Report can be accessed here.


The Report shows that the Darwin average ULP price was 194.8 cpl, 6.8 cpl higher than the average of the five largest capital cities (Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth).

Chart 1: Retail unleaded petrol price (monthly average)





### **Diesel**

The monthly average retail price of diesel across the Territory was 225.9 cpl. This was a decrease of 15.1 cpl from the previous month, however 62.5 cpl higher in annual terms (Chart 4). The monthly average retail diesel price across Australia was 202.2 cpl, a decrease of 20.1 cpl from the previous month, however 55.5 cpl higher in annual terms.


Darwin recorded a monthly average retail diesel price of 212.6 cpl, 18.8 cpl lower than the previous month, however 60.9 cpl higher in annual terms. Darwin had the highest retail price of the capital cities, which ranged from 193.5 cpl in Perth to 209.4 cpl in Canberra (Chart 5).


The TGP for diesel in Darwin was 185.9 cpl, 7.8 cpl lower than last month, however 49.4 cpl higher in annual terms. Darwin's average GIRD for diesel decreased by 11.0 cpl to 26.7 cpl in the month. This was the highest of the capital cities, which otherwise ranged from 9.5 cpl in Adelaide to 17.5 cpl in Brisbane (Chart 6).


### Brent crude oil

The monthly average spot price of Brent crude oil in August 2022 was \$139.90 per barrel in Australian dollar terms (Chart 7). This was a decrease of 3.7% in the month and an increase of 44.6% in annual terms.



The largest component of the TGP is the price of crude oil, followed by the Commonwealth Government's fuel excise and goods and services tax.

<sup>4</sup> Gross indicative retail differences (GIRD) are equal to the monthly average retail price less the monthly average TGP and are used as a broad indication of gross retail fuel margins.
