Medium risk assessment Agency to develop negotiation parameters with central agencies and seek Cabinet approval for any required co-contributions (see Appendix D: Negotiation principles).	High risk assessment Agency to develop negotiation parameters with central agencies andseek Cabinet approval for these and any required co-contributions (see Appendix D: Negotiation principles).
